Plot Summary

Sis, Nan, Ben the Ant, and Sam are riding on Sam's bus when it gets stuck in the mud. Nan tries to fly for help and then she falls into the mud too. Ben the Ant escapes, finds Will the Elephant, and asks for his help. Will rescues Nan and pushes the bus out of the mud. The animals thank Will and are again on their way.

Story Questions (Comprehension)

1. page 2: What happens to the bus?
2. page 5: What happens to Nan?
3. page 8: Who finds Will?
4. pages 12-13: How does Will help his friends?

Each new word throughout the program is repeated at least five times in the book in which it first appears and five more times in the next ten books.

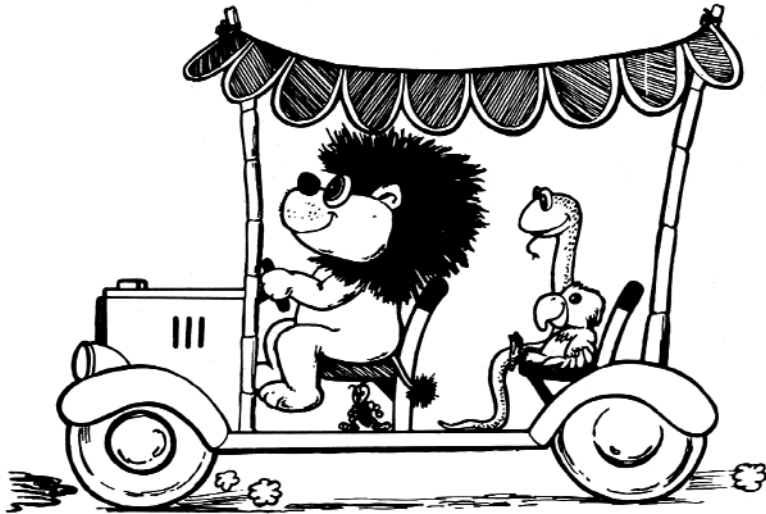

“I will run to Will.”



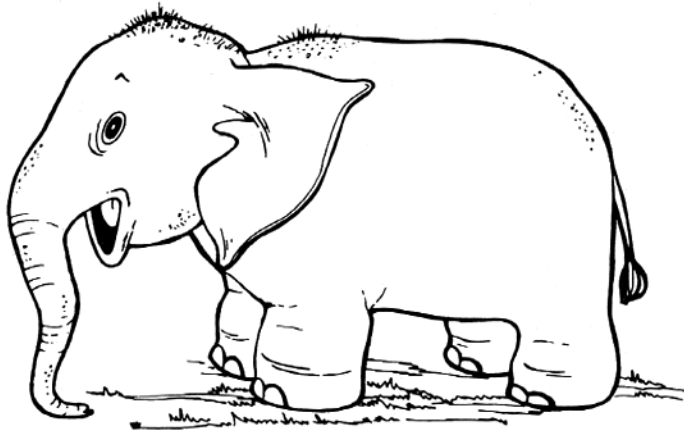
Ben the Ant sees Will.



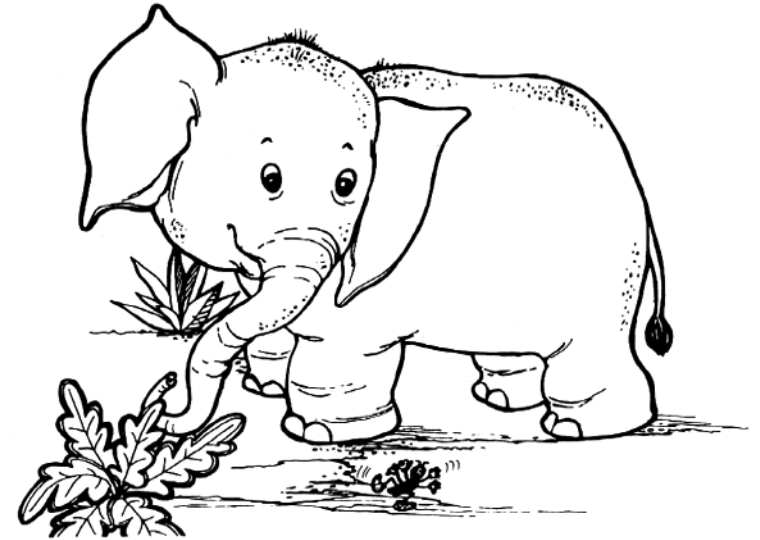
“Will! Will!

The bus is in the mud!

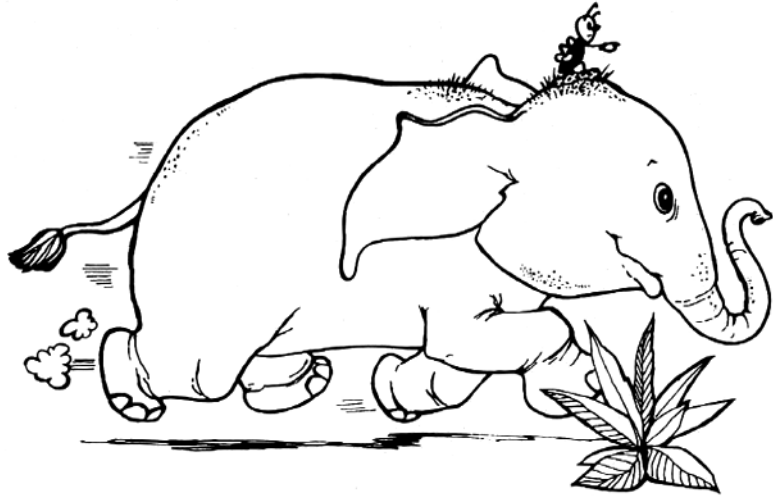
Nan is in the mud!”



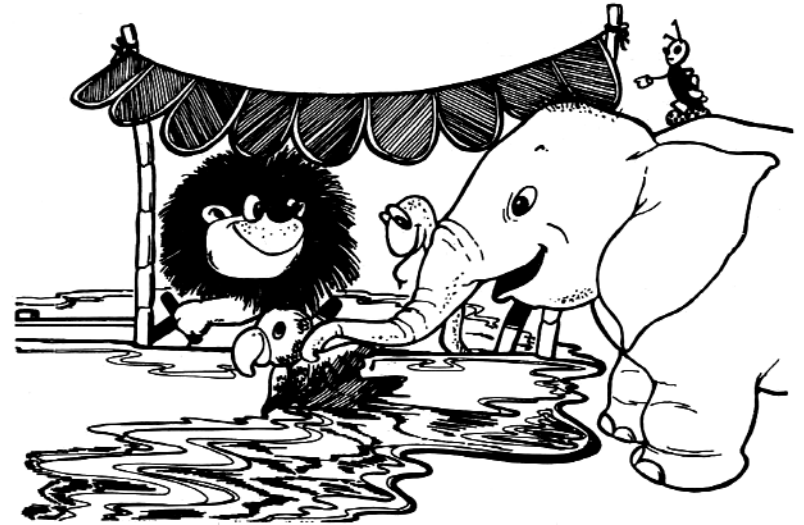
“Is that Ben the Ant?”



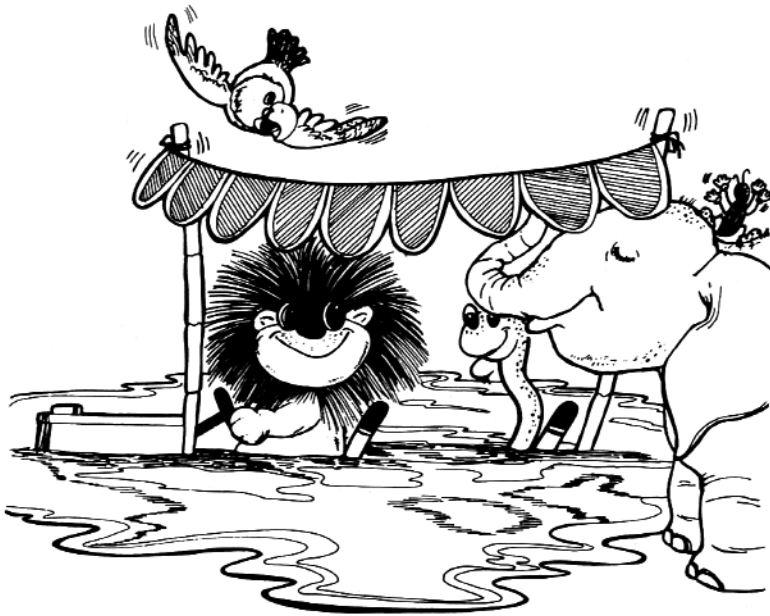
“Nan fell in the mud!
